



The Welsh Pétanque Association Commitments and Objectives 2020-2023

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to provide an outline of Welsh Pétanque Association's Commitments and Objects for 2020-2023.

These will be reviewed annually.

The following areas are covered:

- 1. INSURANCE**
- 2. BURSARIES**
- 3. NATIONAL KIT**
- 4. COMPETITIONS**
- 5. CLUB ASSISTANCE**

1. Insurance

The WPA will provide

- a. Third Party Liability Insurance for all members
- b. Third Party Liability Insurance for the WPA executive
- c. A copy of the certificate will be available on request for clubs to display

2. Bursaries

The WPA will give financial assistance whenever possible in the following areas.

Players

- a. Home Nations to a maximum of £20.
- b. Celtic Challenge to a maximum of £20
- c. PE Inter – Regionals to a maximum of £20
- d. World and European to a maximum of £100.

Coach

- a. Minimum of 40 % to a maximum of 60 % of all costs of Travel, Accommodation and Meals.

3. National Kit

The following kit will be provided free of charge for players / coaches and or managers

- a. One National Shirt for Home Nations / Celtic Challenge Competitions
- b. Two National Shirts for World and European Competitions
- c. One Trousers for World and European Competitions
- d. One National Waterproof Jacket for World, European, Home Nations and Celtic Challenge
- e. One National Fleece for World, European, Home Nations and Celtic Challenge
- f. One WPA Shirt for PE Inter-Regionals.
(Extra shirts will be available to purchase)

4. Competitions

- a. The WPA will financially assist the host club of the Celtic Challenge to a maximum of £200
- b. The WPA will pay all entrance fees to World and European competitions
- c. The WPA will pay for all players and coach gala dinner meals at World and European competitions
- d. The Entrance fee for Welsh Cup 4 Clubs will be ring fenced and awarded to the club who takes up the invitation to compete in the European Cup for Clubs

5. Club Assistance

A sum of £300 / year will be ring fenced to assist clubs with improvements this is the maximum amount available between all clubs and will be apportioned between clubs as is deemed appropriate by the WPA executive, clubs will have to demonstrate what actions they have taken to obtain funding from association such as Community Chest, Sport Wales etc. before financial assistance is awarded from the WPA

These Commitments and Objectives will be reviewed annually and amended in line with the financial situation of the WPA at that time.
