



Player's Bursary Policy

1. The WPA, where possible, is committed to providing financial assistance regarding the expenses incurred by any member representing Wales at the following competitions:
 - a. World Championships organised by the FIPJP
 - b. European Championships organised by the CEP
 - c. Home Nations Championship
 - d. Celtic Challenge
 - e. Pétanque England (PE) Inter-Regionals

2. The maximum bursary paid to a player selected to represent Wales at one of the above championships is set-out below:

World Championship	£100.00	See Note 1.
European Championship	£100.00	See Note 1.
Home Nations Championship	£20.00	Excluded when Wales is the host Nation.
Celtic Challenge	£20.00	
PE Inter-Regional	£20.00	

Note:

[1] In the case of World and European Championships the WPA will encourage Teams to raise additional funds/sponsorship to help with their outlay.

3. The WPA will initially pay for the accommodation and meals in the local currency on behalf of the player. The player will then be invoiced the equivalent amount in GBP (£), which must be settled by the stated date, See Note 2.

Note:

[2] The bursary will be transferred only after the player has paid their invoice in full. The bursary will not be used to off-set the total amount of the invoice owed by the player.

4. The WPA Executive will review the amounts paid as a bursary at the beginning of each year and reserves the right to amend one or all of the bursary payments at any time during the financial year.
