



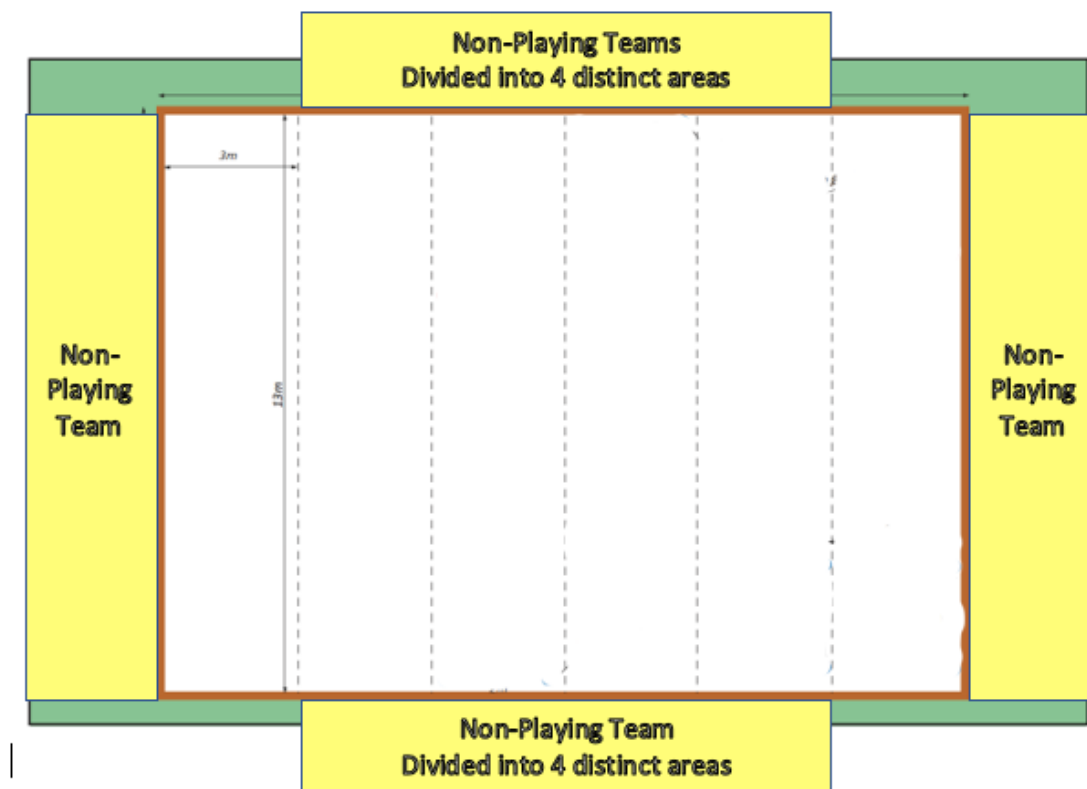
# Guidance for Clubs – Safe Havens.

As part of the WPA’s relaxation of playing restrictions to allow Clubs to get more players taking part, where possible, Clubs may establish “Safe Havens” at the sides and ends of the playing terrain.

These will be used to provide a space where the non-playing Teams can stand while their opponents take their turn. The establishment of Safe Havens means Clubs may then use all their lanes, provided they are a **MINIMUM** of 3m wide.

Where Clubs are unable to establish these Safe Havens, they **MUST** adhere to the previous guidelines and only use alternate lanes for play.

The following graphic illustrates the deployment of Safe Havens.
